

Vietnam has many representatives in the list of the most influential scientists in the world in 2022

Among the top 10,000 leading scientists in the world, Vietnam has 2 representatives: Associate Professor, Dr. Le Hoang Son and Professor, Doctor of Science Nguyen Dinh Duc of Hanoi National University.

Two Vietnamese scientists ranked high in the group of 10,000 most influential scientists in the world in 2022 are Professor, Doctor of Science Nguyen Dinh Duc (left) and Associate Professor, Dr. Le Hoang Son, both from University of Science and Technology, Hanoi National University.

According to the ranking published by Elsevier Publishing House, many Vietnamese scientists have entered the list of “100,000 influential scientists” in 2022.

The list was developed by a group of scientists led by Professor John PA Ioannidis of Stanford University (USA) based on the Scopus database exploitation of Elsevier Publishing House.

This list is evaluated on multiple metrics, including total research citations.

The ranking selected a group of scientists in the top 100, top 10,000 and 100,000 people with the most cited scientific articles out of a total of 200,409 scientists in the database.

In the ranking, there are 35 Vietnamese scientists working at Vietnamese universities.

Among the top 10,000 leading scientists in the world, Vietnam has 2 representatives: Associate Professor, Dr. Le Hoang Son and Professor, Doctor of Science Nguyen Dinh Duc (Hanoi National University).

These two people are on the list for 4 consecutive years 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022.

In particular, many Vietnamese scientists have increased their rankings compared to 2021, such as Associate Professor Tran Xuan Bach (Hanoi Medical University, ranked 12,132 – 19,881 in 2021), Dr. Tran Nguyen Hai (University of Science and Technology). Duy Tan, ranked 13,713 – in 2021 is 14,704), Dr. Hoang Duc Nhat (Duy Tan University, ranked 15,072 – in 2021 is 23,301)...

This year's list has added many new scientists, such as Associate Professor, Dr. Tran Quang Trung (National University of Ho Chi Minh City, ranked 47,614),

Dr. Dao Van Duong (Phenikaa University, ranked 61,711), Dr. Vuong Quan Hoang (Phenikaa University, ranked 61,452), Dr. Chu Dinh Toi (International School, Vietnam National University, Hanoi, ranked 66,906).

Le Thai Ha (34 years old), Fulbright University Vietnam, ranked 49,666 – an increase of more than 24,000 places compared to 2021 (ranked 74,063).

Many foreign scientists working at Vietnamese universities such as Duy Tan University, Ton Duc Thang University, VinUni University, RMIT University... are also on the list.

The ranking also has the names of many Vietnamese scientists working abroad.

This ranking uses Scopus's database from 1960 to September 2022, to select the top 100,000 people with the most cited scientific articles.

The evaluation criteria are based on indicators of influence in the scientific community (total citations, Hirsch h-index; Schreiber hm-index; total citations of articles published as authors. single author, lead author, and a composite index).

Scientists are divided into 22 main fields and 176 sub-fields (disciplines/specialties).

The data shows their influence throughout their career and over the past year.
