

## DHVP Research Publications during 2009-2011

This short paper serves as a summary of some published articles in international outlets by DHVP's personnel during 2011, as a continuation to the preceding years, 2009, 2010.

There are a total of six publications appearing officially by the end of this year, of which three have been published in peer-reviewed journals and three in an online analysis platform, *Stratfor Global Intelligence*.

Our research team conducted several other research manuscripts in 2011, but they will only become ready in 2012 or even later. Most of the upcoming research papers will need to go through peer reviews.

Given DHVP's strategic intent to develop its in-house research capacity, some other important publications have been completed since the beginning of 2009. The most notable publication is the book *Kinh tế Việt Nam: Thăng trầm và đột phá*, published by the National Political Publishing House in May 2009.

Other important research papers during 2009-2010 include: "M&A Market in Vietnam's Transition Economy," "The cultural dimensions of the Vietnamese private entrepreneurship," and *Financial markets in Vietnam's transition economy*.

In conclusion, the 2009-2011 period appears to have been a slow-starting phase of DHVP Research, but the process has gained some momentum by the end of 2011. Given the number of works in the pipeline and research problems under consideration, we expect the 2012-2015 period to become a speed-up phase before a takeoff.
