Nowadays, the way of education in primary or high school is failed to educate students. Instead of educated them it's trained. You can see different view in high education. It uses the art of critical thing. Why?

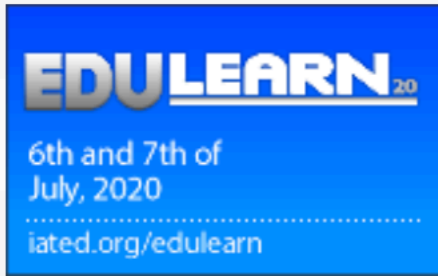
Good critical thinking skills bring numerous benefits such as:
