What Is the Circular Theory?

Zero and one is circumference and diameter. Literally. And, figuratively.



Circularity

We're living on the <u>circumference of a circle</u>. We all know this. It's proven by the <u>horizon</u> (<u>weather</u>, <u>water</u>, <u>waves</u>). Thus, it's easy to forget.

This means we share a circle with a circle (<u>zero and one</u> is circumference and diameter). <u>Nothing more.</u> Or <u>less</u>. Explaining <u>why</u>, and how, <u>50–50</u> is the <u>basis (point)</u> for 'everything.' <u>Why opposites 'attract,' and, then</u>, down-the-road, most definitely, must, 'repel.'

It, also, means, there is a <u>circular relationship</u> between the <u>abstract</u> and concrete (<u>mind</u> and matter). Meaning, if we choose to 'understand it,' or, not, '<u>pi</u>' controls (what a <u>human</u> labels and experiences as) '<u>reality</u>.'

Complementarity


It means there is a <u>circular relationship</u> between (and around) any X and-or Y (<u>X and X'</u>, X and X). And, this is something all of us take for granted. The <u>core 'assumption'</u> in (what a human labels) 'reality.'

Meaning the number 'two' is the core assumption we use for everything.

Circularity explains the <u>universe</u>. A universe. Multiple universes. Starting, and, ending, with <u>the <u>universe</u> <u>called 'mind' (universal mind)</u>. Explaining <u>universality</u> in general (why each '<u>one</u>' of us is in our own 'universe') (why, and how, we can <u>communicate</u> with an '<u>other</u>' '<u>one</u>,' who is, also, in its own '<u>universe</u>').</u>

This is because there is a (<u>mandatory</u>, forced, easily observed and established) circular relationship between <u>mind and matter</u> (abstract and concrete). Meaning, everything around 'you,' is outside of 'you,' and, also, inside of 'you.' A natural <u>oxymoron</u>, <u>contradiction</u>.

It looks like this:




Zero and one. Circumference and diameter. X and Y. Mind and matter. Oxymoron. Contradiction.

Relativity

Where all parts of this diagram articulate the number 'two.' Cosmologists call it <u>radiation</u>, <u>rotation</u>, <u>revolution</u>. <u>Einstein called it 'relativity</u>.' Biologists call it <u>reproduction</u>. Humans call it <u>sex</u>. Ancient people called it <u>yin and yang</u>. Modern people call it <u>zero and one</u>.

This gives us the basis for <u>technology</u>. Information. Data. <u>Strings of characters</u>. The <u>manipulations</u> of strings of <u>characters</u> (<u>if zero</u>, then one, and, always <u>vice versa</u>).

X and Y are joined and, also, separated, by a circle. Meaning <u>pi</u> is the correct name for what a human <u>experiences as mind</u> (mathematical description for <u>observation</u>). Pi as the <u>background state for everything</u>.




Pi. (Complementary Identity)

Representationality

We turn our <u>observations</u> into <u>symbols</u> (as above) because the symbol is a realistic interpretation of a circular reality. Meaning, we can't have a symbol without a line, and the line is always both <u>diameter and circumference</u> of a circle. (Forcing us to realize a circle between us and the symbol turns both 'us' and the 'symbol' into a <u>circle</u>; refer, again, to the <u>diagram</u> above). (Only a circle can circle.)

Circularity is <u>confusing</u>. At first. The diagram above explains (and exposes) it. Calling into question conventional ideas about <u>mathematics</u> (and the role mathematics plays in reality).

However, we can't escape mathematics (as proven by <u>music</u>). <u>Zero and one is X and Y</u> (male and female, diameter and circumference), a basic <u>two-state system</u> which controls, and defines (and also, defends), everything. (Also, known as 'sex.')



Sex. (X and Y) (O and 1) (M and F)


Duality

It takes some time to notice. Or, just remember. You are standing on a circumference, meaning, you cannot escape, or avoid circumference (<u>zero</u>) (and-or one). You share a circle with circumference (meaning, whether you want to know about it or not, you are a <u>circumference</u> yourself). <u>Zero</u> is circumference. As is (any) <u>'one.'</u>

This explains <u>arguments</u>, <u>duplicity</u>, <u>duality</u>, <u>redundancy</u>, <u>fungibility</u>, and <u>reproduction</u>, which are <u>strings of characters</u> defined, and explained by (<u>reducing</u> and <u>expanding</u> to) a zero and a one (circumference and diameter) (arithmetically, the '<u>number</u>' '<u>two</u>'). Nothing <u>more</u>. <u>And-or</u>. Less.


Meaning, the <u>diagram</u>, above (and below), <u>explains</u> (<u>unifies</u>) (and, also, unitizes) everything. Boils down to <u>50–50</u>. Half-of-everything is everything. <u>You already know this</u>. I can't tell you anything you don't already know (<u>mind is universal</u>, joins everything together, forces everything apart) (pi controls reality)(<u>escapes</u>, and produces, <u>time</u>).

In simpler terms, you can't have zero without one (and vice versa). Again, proving <u>50–50</u> is the constant and the norm (a <u>two-state system</u> is <u>embedded</u> in (and responsible for) <u>everything</u>). Why you have to use the '<u>diagram</u>,' if you want to understand 'reality' (<u>Nature</u> in general).



<u>Reality</u>

So, this means an <u>asset is a liablity</u>, and, always, vice versa. Meaning <u>50–50</u> is the <u>constant</u> and the norm. Meaning, 50–50 everything is the 'shortcut' that explains everything. So. any (and-or every) person can take any 'position' on anything (and-or everything), and, more importantly, change (or switch) that 'position' at will. Because <u>any 'position' automatically makes the 'opposing' position 'real.'</u>




Zero is one. Circumference is diameter. Complementary 'position'.

The <u>diagram</u> above proves reality is <u>circular</u>, and, at the same time, <u>linear</u> (meaning, whether you understand it or not (and, whether you think it is 'elegant' to say so, or not), linear is circular, and, always, vice versa). Because everything is connected to, and, also separated from, (relative to) everything else by a line, <u>diameter</u>, and <u>circumference</u>, of a circle. (The diagram is Nature's <u>experience</u> (<u>perspective</u>) (<u>perception</u>) (picture) of, what a human labels, and experiences as, '<u>reality</u>.')


Any <u>symbol</u>, any 'word,' as an example, articulates the conservation of a circle, <u>literally</u>, and, of course, figuratively) (literal and figurative (any X and Y) articulate, and must conserve, a circle). Meaning, from <u>Nature</u>'s point of view (and yours, then, as well) any symbol (any unit) articulates a circle, the diagram(s) above. In arithmetic, the number ('one' is, always,) '<u>two</u>.'

To simplify, one plus one is one. Technically, (symbolized as) the number 'two.'

This is because a 'unit' (any size, speed, location) is the conservation of a circle. Also known, in today's reality, as a 'qubit' (intelligent autonomy). Superposition(al) reality. Background-foreground 'state.' Universal system architecture. The diagram is 'constant.' The words (letters and numbers) (symbols in general) are variable(s).




One and Two (One or Two)




Universal System Architecture




Conservation of the Circle






