

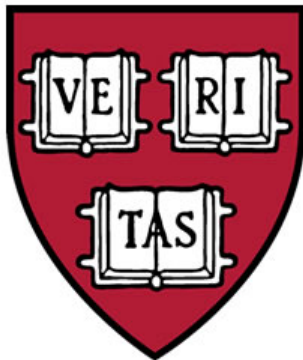
MT is now available at Harvard Library
